Federal Court of Australia Act 1976

ESTABLISHMENT OF REGISTRIES OF THE FEDERAL COURT OF AUSTRALIA

IT IS HEREBY NOTIFIED, for general information, that His Excellency the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, has been pleased, pursuant to sub-sections 34 (1) and (2) of the *Federal Court of Australia Act 1976*—

To establish a Registry of the Federal Court of Australia at Sydney, in the State of New South Wales, and to designate that Registry as the Principal Registry;

To establish a Registry of the Federal Court of Australia at Sydney, in the State of New South Wales, and to specify that that Registry shall be the District Registry in respect of the District of the State of New South Wales;

To establish a Registry of the Federal Court of Australia at Melbourne, in the State of Victoria, and to specify that that Registry shall be the District Registry in respect of the District of the State of Victoria;

To establish a Registry of the Federal Court of Australia at Brisbane, in the State of Queensland, and to specify that that Registry shall be the District Registry in respect of the District of the State of Queensland;

To establish a Registry of the Federal Court of Australia at Adelaide, in the State of South Australia, and to specify that that Registry shall be the District Registry in respect of the District of the State of South Australia;

To establish a Registry of the Federal Court of Australia at Perth, in the State of Western Australia, and to specify that that Registry shall be the District Registry in respect of the District of the State of Western Australia;

To establish a Registry of the Federal Court of Australia at Hobart, in the State of Tasmania, and to specify that that Registry shall be the District Registry in respect of the District of the State of Tasmania;

To establish a Registry of the Federal Court of Australia at Canberra, in the Australian Capital Territory, and to specify that that Registry shall be the District Registry in respect of the District of the Australian Capital Territory;

To establish a Registry of the Federal Court of Australia at Darwin, in the Northern Territory, and to specify that that Registry shall be the District Registry in respect of the District of the Northern Territory.
