INFORMING THE HOUSE:

I seek to update the House with further information relating to the matters revealed by leaked emails in the Synergy360 lobbying scandal. I am happy to be able to report that the heads of the two Agencies for which I am the responsible Minister have today agreed to establish a joint review of this matter.

This will involve the appointment of an eminent Australian working across Services Australia and the NDIA.

This arrangement will ensure there is no real or perceived conflict of interests that might exist were the Agencies to investigate themselves. It will provide important independence as we seek to get to the bottom of whether there was any perversion of the public contracting process. I thank the CEOs of those two agencies, Rebecca Skinner and Rebecca Falkingham respectively, for the speed and seriousness with which they are treating this matter.

Australians taxpayers and voters have the right to know whether corruption has occurred and equally to be assured that government contracting processes are independent and merit based and not being swayed by moneyed special interests.

The terms of reference for this review will be finalised in coming days and weeks.
