Good afternoon

At 10.30am this morning s47F and I attended a meeting at the Aboriginal Tent Embassy (ATE) in relation to the Students of Sustainability (SoS) festival occurring from 1 July to 5 July 2014.

Present at the meeting were reps from NCA and TAMS. The SoS were represented by \$47F s47F . Although \$47F was the main point of contact she left the talking to \$47F'.

The SoS is an "Ideas and arts" festival and conference held at ANU now in its 23rd year. 350 people are expected to attend and the majority of them will be camping with the grounds of the ATE during the week.

The main issue with the festival is a proposed march from the ATE to ANU on Tuesday 1 July from 11am. Organisers informed us that they will be marching on King George Terrace to Commonwealth Ave, across commonwealth ave bridge, through Vernon Circle, left onto London Circuit and right onto University Ave and ending at the University.

TAMS, NCA and ACTP attempted to negotiate with the SoS reps to walk along the footpath, or at the least put in an event application and organise traffic management. All parties explained to SoS that the fundamental reason for doing this is to ensure their safety and the safety of others. It was also explained that marching on the street without any form of traffic management or prior warning may alienate the public and impact negatively on their cause.

Police, TAMS and the NCA will continue to engage with SoS to put traffic management in place for the march.

All parties discussed the remainder of the festival and at this time there is nothing to indicate there will be any issues for Police. All conferences and events will be held at ANU and transport to and from the ATE will be via private vehicles and public transport. NCA informed the organisers that they are not to camp or set up facilities on Commonwealth land outside the tent embassy. The SoS is not affiliated with the AYCC National Summit occurring on 6 July but believe there will be attendees who will remain in Canberra to participate in the National Summit. The West Papuan flag raising ceremony will be held on Wednesday 2 July at the ATE and SoS attendees will participate in this event before heading to ANU for conferences.

The organisers stipulated their cause is peaceful, but agreed there were people attending who are seasoned and passionate protestors, and that should these people cause trouble the SoS would not hinder Police in carrying out their duty. They could not provide Police with a list of attendees who were of concern.

About 1.30pm this date I spoke with s47F from TAMS who is of the belief that SoS won't make an event application as they won't be able to afford traffic management or public liability insurance. As such TAMS is preparing to organise a traffic management plan in the interest of public safety. s47F has informally requested the assistance of NCA and Police in the preparation and execution of this plan.

I will keep you updated on any further developments.
