- *Copies of any additional correspondence between the ACC and the Serious Fraud Office*

For the period from 1 May 2015 to the date of your request.

We received your request on *Tuesday 26 May 2015* and the 30 day statutory period for processing your request commenced from the day after that date. You should therefore expect a decision from us by **Thursday 25 June 2015**. The period of 30 days may be extended if we need to consult third parties or for other reasons. We will advise you if this happens.
