When Client Service Officer s. 22(1)(a)(ii) asked detainee s. 47F(1) to leave the area he swore at Client Service Officer s. 22(1)(a)(ii) (see related IR abusive/aggressive)

s. 47F(1) detainee s. 47F(1) then started yelling at Client Service Officer s. 22(1)(a)(ii) ?I will fucking kill you no one talks to my mate like that, I will fucking show you.?

Detainee s. 47F(1) then tried to gain access through the Shoalhaven Observation gate but Client Service Officers s. 22(1)(a)(ii) & s. 22(1)(a)(ii) held the gate.

HE WAS ASKED BY CSO s. 22(1)(a)(ii) TO LEAVE BSV PREMISES WHEN HE BECAME ABUSIVE BY SAYING - "WHO THE FUCK ARE YOU TO TELL ME, WHY CAN THIS GUY BE HERE AND NOT ME?".
