Upon Arrival at Villawood Immigration Detention Centre you were inducted into the centre and you signed a copy of your rights and responsibilities whilst you are accommodated at VIDC.

Your responsibilities are attached to the back of this form.

On 29.03.15 at 1630hrs you breached section 7 of your responsibilities by

Threatening to Kill a Serco Officer.

As a result of this breach you are being reminded that you are to follow the terms of the rights and responsibilities you signed upon induction.

Any further breaches may result in you being moved to another part of the centre; or having your movements in the centre restricted; or being transferred to another facility in the immigration detention network.

Description: On the 29th March 2015 at approximately 1630hrs Client Service Officer s. 22(1)(a)(ii) noticed s. 47F(1) detainee s. 47F(1) in the Shoalhaven observation unit lighting a cigarette from the wall mounted unit.

When Client Service Officer s. 22(1)(a)(ii) asked detainee s. 47F(1) to leave the area as he was not a border screening detainee, detainee s. 47F(1) replied to him ?Who the fuck are you to tell me, why can this guy be here (referring to the male border screening detainee) and not me?.

s. 47F(1) detainee s. 47F(1) then started yelling threats at Client Service Officer s. 22(1)(a)(ii) and then tried to gain access through the gate. (see related IR assault minor)

A code black was then called by Client Service Officer s. 22(1)(a)(ii) due to detainee s. 47F(1) escalating behaviour and detainee s. 47F(1) refusal to leave the Shoalhaven Observation Compound.

Client Service Manager s. 22(1)(a)(ii) responded to the code and told detainee s. 47F(1) not to enter the Shoalhaven Observation unit as it was a restricted area.

When Client Service Manager s. 22(1)(a)(ii) tried to speak to detainee s. 47F(1) about his rights and responsibilities later that evening, he refused to sign the acknowledgement and walked off.
