2	How many teachers passed the TIP?	NOT AVAILABLE FROM PUBLISHED DATA Information would have to be collected manually - formal GIPA application required
3	How many teachers resigned following a TIP?	NUMBER OF 'TEACHERS DIRECTED TO RESIGN' is shown in the published data for each reporting period. Total numbers for 5-year period would have to be collected manually - formal GIPA application required
4	How many were dismissed?	THIS DATA IS PUBLISHED – FROM 2008-2014, A TOTAL OF 263 TEACHERS WERE DISMISSED – information is publicly available.
