Freedom of Information Request – correspondence between the Chief Minister and his Office and the Director of Public Policy for Uber

Processing Charges

Processing charges may be payable in relation to time spent in searching for and retrieving relevant documents, decision-making time and photocopying. In the event the decision-maker decides that you are liable to pay a charge in respect of the processing of your request, you will be notified of the preliminary assessment of the charge and have full opportunity to contend that the charge should not be imposed or should be reduced.
