NOTICE OF DECISION ON FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

- I refer to your correspondence, dated 27 November 2015, in which you requested access, under the Freedom of Information Act 1982 (FOI Act), to:
 - "...documents which show the budget allocated to the Australian Signals Directorate in the 2015-16 financial year

Exclude the personal details of its officers, such as names, signatures, mobile telephone numbers and private email addresses, contained in documents that fall within the scope of an FOI request

Exclude duplicates of documents, and documents sent to, or received from you."

Background

- On 1 December 2015, our office informed you that the statutory deadline for you to receive 2. a response to this FOI request was 27 December 2015.
- The purpose of this letter is to provide you with the decision relating to the documents that 3. are the subject of your request.

FOI decision maker

4. Mrs Anush Avakian, Director Contract Management, Intelligence and Security Group is the authorised officer pursuant to section 23 of the FOI Act to make a decision on this FOI request.

Decision and reasons for the decision

- The document identified as matching the scope of your request is exempt from the operation of the FOI Act.
- Subsection 7(2A) of the FOI Act provides that agencies that are otherwise subject to the FOI Act are exempt from the operation of the FOI Act in relation to documents that originated with, or that have been received from, specifically intelligence agencies, including the Australian Signals Directorate (ASD).

7. In light of the above, Mrs Avakian decided to refuse access to the requested document on the grounds that the document originated in an intelligence agency which is exempt under section 7 of the FOI Act.

Your Review Rights
