Re: Freedom of Information (FOI) Request

I refer to your request under the Freedom of Information Act 1982 (FOI Act) to:

"a copy of documents and records involving the Trans-Pacific Partnership (TPP) meeting in Atlanta, Georgia (30 Sep.-1 Oct. 2015) including the keywords "regulation" or "medicine"".

I am authorised under section 23 of the FOI Act to make decisions, and have been appointed to be the decision-maker on your request in line with Departmental procedures.

This notice is to advise you that a search of files undertaken by the Department's Goods and Investment Branch, Office of Trade Negotiations and a further, centralised search of all Departmental electronic files undertaken by the Department's Corporate Records Section, Business Applications Branch has failed to identify any documents or files relating to the topic and timeframe of your request.

I am therefore satisfied that the documents sought do not exist and therefore in accordance with the provisions of section 24A(1)(b)(ii) of the FOI Act, your request for access is refused.
