I refer to your application under the ACT Freedom of Information Act 1989 (the Act), received by ACT Health on 29 February 2016, in which you requested access to documents regarding complaints relating to infection control.

Under section 18 of the Act, an agency must take all reasonable steps to notify you of a decision on your application within 30 days. The 30 day period in relation to your request ends on Wednesday 30 March 2016.

Processing charges may be payable in relation to your request. Should you be liable to pay a processing charge, you will be notified in writing of the preliminary assessment and given an opportunity to make an application that the charge should be remitted in whole or in part. This may affect the time within which your application must be processed.

Any charges that may be payable in relation to your request will be assessed in accordance with the *Freedom of Information (Fees) Determination 2015*.
