**Freedom of Information request  
Request No. 160511**

On 15 June 2016 a letter was sent to you advising that the Department had determined to impose charges in relation to your FOI request and advising that amount of those charges had been calculated as \$460.33.

The Department provided you with 30 days in which to provide notification that you would:

- agree to pay the charge,
- wish to contend that the charge has been wrongly assessed, should be reduced or not imposed or both; and if so provide reasons, or
- withdraw the request.

Section 29 of the Freedom of Information Act 1982 (the FOI Act) provides that if an applicant fails to undertake one of the above options within the 30 day period, the request is taken to have been withdrawn. To date the Department has not:

- received any payment for the request,
- received any correspondence indicating that you wish to contend that the charge has been wrongly assessed, should be reduced or not imposed or both; or
- received a withdrawal request.

As the 30 day prescribed timeframe has now elapsed your request is taken to be withdrawn.
