ATTACHMENT A

Review by the Information Commissioner

Section 54L of the FOI Act provides that a person may apply for a review to the Information Commissioner concerning the decision made by an agency on internal review of an original decision.

An application for a Review by the Information Commissioner must occur within 60 days from the time that the agency has provided you with its decision. The application must be made in writing (including email) and should be directed to the following address:

An application for review through the Information Commissioner must include contact details for the applicant and a copy of the notice of decision as given by the agency under section 26.

The Information Commissioner usually prefers applicants to seek internal review before asking for a review through their office.
