Re: FREEDOM OF INFORMATION DETERMINATION

I refer to your application made to the South Australian Museum under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (the Act) received on 14 September 2016, seeking access to:

- “Digital copies of cetacean stranding event and necropsy reports associated with the following two incidents: the stranding of a southern right whale carcass at Point Bolingbroke, Eyre Peninsula (August 2013) and the stranding of a pod of female sperm whales near Ardrossan, Yorke Peninsula (December 2014).”
