# Access Decision - Freedom of Information (FOI) request - Release of documents

This letter refers to an access request received under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (the FOI Act) on 21 September 2016, seeking access to:

*'the number of Visa applications approved in year 2016 under the Subclass 189 for the following ANZSCO codes* 

261111 - ICT business Analyst 261112 - Systems Analyst 261311 - Analyst Programmer 261312 - Developer Programmer 261313 - Software Engineer 263111 - Computer Network and Systems Engineer 263311 - Telecommunications Engineer 263312 - Telecommunications Network Engineer'

On 12 October 2016, you clarified the timeframe of your request to be for the period *between the 1 January 2016 to 31 August 2016.* 

### Timeframe for processing your request

The FOI Act provides a statutory period for processing your request of 30 calendar days, unless an extension of time is agreed to, or provided for under a provision of the FOI Act.

On 17 October 2016, the Department wrote to you requesting a further 30 days within which to make a decision on your request.

On 18 October 2016, you agreed in writing to this extension of time. Pursuant to section 15AA of the FOI Act, the Department has notified the Information Commissioner in writing of this extension of time.

The due date for a decision on your request is 20 November 2016.

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### Authority to make decision

I am an officer authorised under section 23 of the FOI Act to make decisions in respect of requests to access documents or to amend or annotate Departmental records.

# Information considered

In reaching my decision, I have considered the following:

- the Freedom of Information Act 1982;
- the Australian Information Commissioner's FOI guidelines relating to access to documents held by government;
- the terms of your request;
- Departmental document, (identified below); and
- consultation with relevant business area.

# Decision

In accordance with section 17 of the FOI Act, the Department has used its computer system to produce one document that contains the requested information. The data produced in this document existed in the possession of the Department on 21 September 2016 when your FOI request was received.

I have decided to release the document in full.

# **Review rights**

### Internal review

If you disagree with my decision, you have the right to apply for an internal review by the Department of my decision. Any request for internal review must be provided to the Department within 30 days of you being notified of the decision. Where possible please attach reasons why you believe review of the decision is necessary. The internal review will be carried out by an officer other than the original decision-maker and the Department must make a review decision within 30 days.
