### **RE: YOUR FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST**

I refer to your application of 14 November 2016 to the ABS for an Internal Review under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (FOI Act) regarding the decisions made by Ms Williams, an authorised decision maker under section 23 of the FOI Act, on 11 November in regards to your request for information under the FOI Act (FOI ref 201617/42).

#### **Internal Review of the Decision**

I am an authorised decision maker under section 23 of the FOI Act and, in compliance with section 54C of the FOI Act, am an appropriate person to review the decision made by Ms Williams.

#### **Findings of the Internal Review**

I have reviewed the process used to search for documents pertaining to your request, the subsequent handling of your request and the decision reached regarding the specific contents released to you.

I have decided to uphold the original decision made by Ms Williams on the basis of the amount of effort that would be required to process the request under the current scope.

I have also provided a link below to the MacGibbon Review of the events surrounding the eCensus as this was not available at the time of your original request and contains information relevant to your request:

If you wish to seek the information through a new FOI request, I would suggest further refining the scope to include only the emails that relate to the staff involved in Census information technology systems and security to reduce to effort required to process the request.

### **Review by the Information Commissioner**

Section 54L of the FOI Act provides that a person may apply for a review to the Information Commissioner concerning the decision made by an agency on internal review of an original decision.

An application for a Review by the Information Commissioner must be occur within 60 days from the time that the agency has provided you with its decision. The application must be made in writing (including email) and should be directed to the following address:

An application for review through the Information Commissioner must include contact details for the applicant and a copy of the notice of decision as given by the agency under section 26.
