Application for documents under the Commonwealth Freedom of Information Act 1982

I refer to your Freedom of Information request received by Australia Post on 3 October 2016 in which you sought access to documents under the Freedom of Information Act 1982 (“**FOI Act**”). You have sought the following from Australia Post:


“...the latest document.....that describes or reviews [Australia Post’s] policy for tracking, monitoring or intercepting mail to specific groups or individuals....”
