## Re: Freedom of Information (FOI) Request

I refer to your e-mail of 20 October in which you seek access under the provisions of the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (FOI Act) to:

an Itemised account for sending 20+ employees to France so as to learn how to save money, and to include but not limited to airfare costs, accommodation costs, food costs, beverage costs, seminar / course costs and any other costs billed to the Australian Taxpayer.

I am authorised under section 23 of the FOI Act to make decisions, and have been appointed to be the decision-maker on your request in line with departmental procedures.

I advise that a search of files undertaken by the relevant line areas has failed to identify any document relevant to the scope of your request. The document which you request does not exist. I note in this regard OAIC FOI Guideline 2.30, which states that 'The right of access applies to documents that exist at the time that FOI request was made. An applicant cannot insist that their request cover documents created after the request is received.'

I am therefore unable to meet your request in accordance with the provisions of section 24A(1)(b)(ii) as DFAT holds no documents relevant to your request.

Please find your rights of review outlined below.

## Internal review

Under the provisions of section 54 of the FOI Act, you are entitled to request a review of my decision. Your request should be made in writing and sent within 30 days of receipt of this letter addressed to:
