**INSTRUMENT OF AUTHORITY UNDER SECTION 23(1) OF THE ACT TO MAKE
DECISIONS UNDER THE ACT**

I, Leigh Wilton, as the Principal Officer of the Australian Military Forces Relief Trust Fund (Army Relief Trust Fund) for the purpose of the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (the FOI Act);

- a) Revoke all prior instruments of authorisation made und the Act: and
- b) Authorise the Secretary of the Army Relief Trust Fund powers and functions under the following parts of the Act:
 - Part III – access to documents;
 - Part IV – exempt documents; and
 - Part V – amendments an annotation of personal records.
- c) I shall retain responsibilities under Part VI – internal review of decisions.

When required on matters of complexity the Secretary will consult with myself and as required with the Department of Defence.
