

Enrolment Applications for Itinerant Electors

Applications for itinerant enrolment must be made on the approved **Application for Enrolment for Persons with No Fixed Address** form. (See Valid Enrolment Applications) Applicants do not need to complete an ordinary enrolment form.

The application must:

- be signed by the applicant. The exception to this is people who cannot sign their name because of physical incapacity. **Note:** Legal Power of Attorney is not an acceptable substitute for the applicant's signature or mark.
- include proof of identity
- and where applicable, include legislative requirements for state enrolment.
