Freedom of Information Request

I refer to your application dated 5 January 2017 in which you sought access to the following documents under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (the Act):

I request access to any document that shows how much it cost the Australian Federal Police to use Gamma International's Finfisher in the years 2011, 2012, 2013 or 2014.

On 13 January 2017 the AFP made a decision on your request. On 8 February 2017 you sought internal review of that decision.

This letter sets out my decision on internal review. I am an authorised decision-maker under section 23 of the FOI Act.

DECISION

Pursuant to section 25 of the Act, this agency neither confirms nor denies the existence of such a document in relation to your request. Assuming the existence of such a document, it would be an exempt document by virtue of under section 33 or subsection 37(1) of the Act.

RIGHTS OF REVIEW

If you are dissatisfied with this decision, you may seek a review by the *Information Commissioner (IC)*

In making your application you need to provide:

- an address for notices to be sent (this can be an email address).
- A copy of this decision.

It would also help if you set out the reasons for review in your application.
