## Freedom of Information Request No.17-1

I refer to your request for access to documents relating to correspondence between ASADA and the Minister for Health. I have taken your request to be for:

 All documents, communications and/or correspondence including emails, text messages, file notes, briefings, reports and phone records exchanged between the Minister for Health, Sussan Ley and a member of ASADA between 23/12/14 and 13/1/17.

If you believe that the scope of your request has not been interpreted correctly please advise the contact officer on the details outlined at the conclusion of this letter.

We received your request on Friday 20 January 2017 and the 30 day statutory period for processing your request commenced from the day after that date. You should therefore expect a decision from us by *Monday 20 February 2017* (noting that the 30 day period expires on previous Sunday).
