# **Background:**

At approximately 2345 on Tuesday 24 May 2011, CSO FRUEAN saw s. 47F(1) s. 47F(1) laying under a tree in the Green Heart. CSO FRUEAN asked what was wrong. s. 47F(1) did not respond. Instead s. 47F(1) handed CSO FRUEAN a piece of paper with a hand written message s. 47F(1)

CSM ALI attended and tried to speak with S. 47F(1) but still refused to talk. CSM ALI advised S. 47F(1) that this incident would also be classified as a protest and would reflect on his character report and yet, still no response.

Serco continued to monitor the behaviour of the detainee.
