1. A number of Clients from Gold 2 attended Green 1 to s37(2) (b), s40 with other s33(1)(a)(iii) from this (1)(d) location. Information is that this developed into a physical altercation between both Afghani and Sri Lankan clients s33(1)(a)(iii)

This has developed into a physical altercation with a number of clients requiring medical treatment

for scratch's a injured arm and 4 stitch's within the head.

Incident Details

Description: On Saturday the 21st of November 2009 at 8.50PM a physical confrontation took place between approximately s37(2)(b), s40(1)(d) of both Afghanistan and Sri Lankan nationalities. This Incident lasted for approximately 30 minutes. This incident followed a smaller incident at 1630hours on the 21st of November within Green 1 involving both Sri-Lankan and Afghani Clients of which a number of clients were involved.

The Incident at 8.50PM started within Green 1 Compound involving numerous clients from different

Compounds but it was between only Afghanistan and Sri Lankan nationalities. Clients within Green

1 compound began to strike each other s37(2)(b), s40(1)(d)

Staff attended the location and attempted to intercede s37(2)(b), s40(1)(d)

Staff members attempted to s37(2)(b), and withdraw clients to safe areas as the situation s40(1)(d)

spilled into the Green Heart area, approximately s37(2)(b), from both nationalities continued to s40(1)(d)

strike each other s37(2)(b), s40(1)(d)
s37(2)(b), s40(1)(d)

A number of s37(2)(b), s40(1)(d) who were in the Green Heart area as the disturbance spilled from (d)

Green 1 compound armed themselves with s37(2)(b), s40(1)(d)
s37(2)(b), s40(1)(d)

Staff s37(2)(b), s40(1)(d) and at the same time moved others not involved and injured clients s37(2)(b), s40(1)(d) (1)(d)
s37(2)(b), s40(1)(d)

s37(2)(b), s40(1)(d) Staff members interceded on a number of occasions in attempts to take weapons from clients and protect injured or isolated clients from harm or further injury.

The situation ended when all s33(1)(a)(iii) had been isolated from the s33(1)(a)(iii) clients. The s33(1)(a)(iii) clients then made their way to the middle of the Green Heart and refused to return to their accommodation areas.

Staff members then continued to take s37(2)(b), s40(1)(d) from the clients which were secured, staff (1)(d)

members then began to attend to injured clients within numerous areas a total of 37 Clients the

majority being s37(2)(b), were transported to medical, at 0340 hours this morning 16 Clients s40(1)(d)

were at Christmas Island Hospital some who will remain but of which a majority will return to North

West Point.
