

Dear Professor Dungan Annabella,

Thank you for your letter of 20 February 2017 about the relocation of the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) to Armidale. I appreciate your perspectives on this as we move to establish a Centre of Agricultural Excellence in Armidale.

The successful relocation of the APVMA to Armidale is one of my highest priorities and I am committed to working with the University of New England (UNE) to ensure its success. The Australian Government has invested \$25.6 million and the APVMA has developed a Relocation Strategy to support the move and mitigate identified risks.

I agree that staff turnover is a challenge the APVMA must manage, as would any organisation undergoing change. In this context, I am pleased that recent recruitment activities have attracted many applications. I expect the APVMA will maintain a programme of vigorous, rolling recruitment, particularly for staff to work in Armidale. Many people are already contacting my office to express interest in employment with the APVMA in Armidale and I am confident there are many more high quality candidates right across the region and beyond.

Further, as you have identified, the APVMA has foreshadowed generous incentives to encourage existing staff to move to Armidale, or otherwise to stay for the transition period and continue to assess applications and train new recruits. I understand that draft relocation and retention policies for current APVMA staff will be finalised shortly.

On your suggestion to appoint an officer responsible for coordinating the relocation, I am advised the APVMA has recruited an experienced senior executive level Relocation Operations Manager, funded by the government's relocation package. He will be responsible for the overall planning, scheduling and delivery of the logistics of the relocation, including property related matters, as well as ensuring appropriate risk management, procurement, governance, record keeping and staff liaison arrangements are in place. I have passed on to the APVMA your offer to provide temporary accommodation space at the UNE.

I would like to congratulate you on establishing two new regulatory science post-graduate award courses. I understand you already have nine students enrolled in the first unit of study and that many of these were motivated to enrol by the opportunity for employment with the APVMA in Armidale. These courses are an important step towards establishing the Centre of Agricultural Excellence and will provide graduate scientists in the region with a clear pathway from study through to employment.

Finally, I am aware the APVMA has committed to engaging with stakeholders during the relocation and appreciate the UNE's contribution. Your input, particularly to the APVMA's Relocation Advisory Committee, will greatly contribute to the success of the move.

Thank you again for your letter.
