Request for access to documents under the Freedom of Information Act 1982

I refer to your *Freedom of Information Act* (FOI Act) request sent to the ACMA on Friday, 16 June 2017 at 7:50pm and to my letter of acknowledgement dated 26 June 2017.

The documents which fall within the terms of your request contain personal information about third persons.

Subsection 47F(1) of the FOI Act relevantly provides:

A document is conditionally exempt if its disclosure under this Act would involve the unreasonable disclosure of personal information about any person (including a deceased person).

As the persons whose personal information appears in these documents may reasonably wish to contend that the information is exempt under section 47F of the FOI Act, the ACMA is required, in accordance with section 27A of the FOI Act, to give them a reasonable opportunity to make submissions in relation to the application of the exemption.

Time limit for processing your request

To enable third party consultation to occur, the statutory time period for processing the request has, in accordance with subsection 15(6) of the FOI Act, been extended by an additional 30 days (ie 16 August 2017).

The decision on access will be made as soon as practical, but in any event by 16 August 2017 unless the timeframe is further extended under the Act. You will be notified should there be a further extension.
