### NOTICE OF DECISION

I refer to your request to the Department of Health (Department) of 19 June 2017 seeking access under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (FOI Act) to:

*'A copy of any agreement, contract, or any document which may or may not be enforceable by law between Mr. Dean Robinson, an Australian fitness coach who has worked with a variety of both AFL and NRL clubs, and the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA). The agreement, contract, or any such document may include other parties and if so, is covered by this request. I also require copies of all correspondence (electronic and print) between Mr Robinson and ASADA and any officials in preparing and finalising that agreement, contract, or any such document'*

I am writing to advise you of my decision.

#### Decision

I am authorised under section 23(1) of the FOI Act to make decisions in relation to FOI requests.

All reasonable steps have been taken to find the documents referred to in your request including a thorough and extensive search and consultation with the relevant policy and program areas.

I am satisfied that the documents referred to in your request do not exist.

As a consequence, I refuse access to the documents referred to in your request pursuant to section 24A of the FOI Act.

#### Review rights

If you are dissatisfied with my decision, you may apply for an internal review or Australian Information Commissioner (Information Commissioner) review of the decision.

### Internal review

Under section 54 of the FOI Act, you may apply in writing to the Department for an internal review of my decision. The internal review application must be made within 30 days of the date of this notice (or such further period as the Department allows). Where possible please provide reasons why you consider review of the decision is necessary. The internal review will be carried out by another officer of this Department within 30 days. 
