**Request for access to documents under the Freedom of Information Act 1982**

I refer to your request made under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (the **FOI Act**) on 24 June 2017 for:

*[...] documents which detail the precise monies paid to each of ACMA's SES officers in the following financial years - FY2013/14, FY 2014/15 and FY2015/16. The group certificates/end-of-year PAYG payments summaries issued by ACMA to each of its SES staff in those years can be quickly and easily identified and retrieved, and will efficiently and accurately provide the information the subject of my request.*

The documents which fall within the terms of your request contain personal information.

Section 47F of the FOI Act relevantly provides:

(1) A document is conditionally exempt if its disclosure under this Act would involve the unreasonable disclosure of personal information about any person (including a deceased person).

As the individuals whose personal information appears in these documents may reasonably wish to contend that the information is exempt under section 47F of the FOI Act, I have decided, in accordance with section 27A of the FOI Act, to give those individuals a reasonable opportunity to make submissions in relation to the application of the exemption.

*Time limit for processing your request*

To enable this third party consultation, the statutory time period for processing the request has, in accordance with subsection 15(6) of the FOI Act, been extended by an additional 30 days.

The decision on access will be made as soon as practical, but in any event by 23 August 2017 unless the timeframe is further extended under the Act. You will be notified should there be a further extension.
