· After the buses turn right from Derrimut road into Tarneit

interchange suddenly cars in front of the buses turn left into the entrance towards dirt road car park although CDC Victoria does not have any objections to the car park on this side but due to the location of the entrance which is just after a steep descent in the road creating a safety hazard for the driver to apply harsh braking. Possible solution: Move the entrance further 50+75 metres to provide bigger gap.

65NB 900 mm hot dip galvanized pipe heavy wall with cap & reflective band (currently installed at Melbourne end of station)

This option would cost about \$30,000 (quote \$14k to supply and install) and includes risk, V/Line PM costs & traffic management. These ones are already used on site, but they are really just a light duty bollard that offers a visual barrier.

The work will take around 2 weeks as the crew would be working on weekends only.

Option 2:

Fixed Bollard – Surface Mount Bollard 140*1200mm off shelf impact one's (currently installed in the car park)

This option would cost about \$65,000-\$70000 (each bollard is \$218 ea. and there is additional labour cost) and includes risk, V/Line PM costs & traffic management. The cost delta is because these bollards are superior quality and more robust that can handle vehicle impacts much better.

The work will take around 2 weeks as the crew would be working on weekends only.

Bollards will be installed around 1.5m from kerb depending on location of existing underground cables, and are spaced 1.5 apart. The small yellow line is for 6 bolt down bollards to prevent car parking on bicycle path as is being done now.

If you are after a quick fix, I recommend **Option 1** as they are easier to install and replicate the existing ones on site. Option 2 is by far the better outcome but costs are doubled.

During the meeting,	from V/Line raised the issue of Tarneit Car Park.

The Issue:

Tarneit Car Park currently has about 1,000 spaces available. A safety issue has been raised as on weekdays approximately 1,400 cars utilise the facility, causing overloading of the facility.

Due to the overloading, Cars are illegally parking on the grass, footpaths and in other unmarked areas within the car park, which is causing safety concerns. Just this week, it was reported that someone drove into a pole within the car park, and congestion within the facility continues to pose problems.
