NOTICE OF LIABILITY TO PAY A CHARGE

I refer to your request to the Department of Health (the Department) of 9 October 2013 in which you have sought access under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (the FOI Act) to a copy of the Blue book prepared for the incoming Health Minister, Peter Dutton.

I have decided, in accordance with section 29, of the FOI Act that you are liable to pay a charge in respect to the processing of your request. Under paragraph 29(1)(f) of the FOI Act you are required to notify the Department in writing and within 30 days, or such other period as the Department allows, that:

- you agree to pay the charge;
- you wish to make contention (refer below); or
- you withdraw your request.

Preliminary Assessment:

In accordance with paragraph 29(1)(b) of the FOI Act my preliminary assessment of the charge is \$1101.36. This has been calculated as follows:

- (a) whether the payment of the charge, or part of it, would cause financial hardship to you or the person on whose behalf the application was made; and
- (b) whether the giving of access to the document[s] in question is in the general public interest or in the interest of a substantial section of the public.

Timeframe for processing your request:

The processing of your request is suspended from the date you receive this notice until either you pay a deposit or your contention to pay the charge has been resolved.
