Request for access to documents under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982*

The purpose of this email is to provide you with a decision about documents that you requested under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (FOI Act).

Summary

I, Dominique Tubier, confirm that I am an authorised decision maker within the meaning of section 23 of the FOI Act.

I refer to your FOI request that the Office of the eSafety Commissioner ('the Office') received on 25 May 2018, in which you sought access to:

Any information your Office holds regarding User Experience, User Interaction or even Technical research around the "Quick Exit" button that exists on a subset of the Office's website.

I have identified 23 documents falling within the scope of your request. To obtain these, the Office searched our records systems. The Office also contacted relevant individuals and asked them to provide any documents relating to the matters outlined in your request.

Please note that document 23 has been provided in response to your subsequent email of 20 June 2018.
