Freedom of Information Request No. 201800066

On 28 September 2018, The Australian National University (ANU) received your request for access to documents under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982*.

You have requested access to the following documents:

- 1. All agreements, such as Memorandums of Understanding, agreed between the Australian National University Crawford School of Public Policy and the ANU Law School, and the Commonwealth Parliamentary Library in the last two years.
- 2. All documents related to the negotiation and concluding of those agreements.
- 3. All documents related to the interactions between the Parliamentary Library and each of the Crawford School of Public Policy and the ANU Law School since those agreements came into effect.
- 4. All documents related to requests from the Parliamentary Library for work or services (however described) under those agreements
- 5. All work performed under those agreements.

I am an officer authorised under section 23 of the FOI Act to make decisions in respect of requests to access documents. The statutory timeframe for processing a request is 30 days from the date upon which your application was received by the ANU. Should a third party consultation be required, your request may be extended by an additional 30 days. We will advise you if this happens.

Charges

I am also writing to advise you that you are liable to pay a charge for the processing of your request. In accordance with section 29 of the FOI Act and the *Freedom of Information Charges Regulations 1982*, my preliminary assessment of total charges payable is **\$400**.

Basis for my preliminary assessment of the charge

I have assessed the work The Australian National University (ANU) would need to do to process your request and have calculated the following breakdown of charges:

Your right to contend the charge

Under the FOI Act, you have the right to contend that the charge:

- has been wrongly assessed, or
- should be reduced, or
- should not be imposed.

In deciding whether a charge should be reduced or not imposed, the decision maker in our agency must take into account:

- whether payment of the charge, or part of it, would cause you financial hardship
- whether giving access to the documents is in the general public interest or in the interest of a substantial section of the public
- any other relevant matter.

Payment of charges

As the charge exceeds \$100, a deposit of \$80 (25%) is required.

Please be advised that the deposit is not refundable except in some limited circumstances (for example, if the ANU fails to make a decision on your request within the statutory time limit), or may be refundable in part if the final charge is less than the deposit paid.

The time you have to respond and what you need to do

You have 30 days to respond in writing to this notice. We therefore expect a response from you by 3 **November 2018**. By that date, you must do one of the following things in writing:

- agree to pay the charge (this will mean that you will not be entitled to access the requested documents until the full charge is paid)
- contend that the charge has been wrongly assessed, or should be reduced or not imposed and explain your reasons
- withdraw your request

The period for processing your request is suspended from the day that you receive this notice and resumes on either the day you pay the charge (in full or the required deposit) or the day on which this agency makes a decision not to impose a charge.

If you do not provide us with a written response by 3 November 2018 your request will be taken to have been withdrawn.
