I understand that you have been speaking with [REDACTED].

I am writing to apologise that the ROC appears to have sent an email, intended for you, to another email address (a person apparently based in [REDACTED]). It seems that this was because a difference of one character between the two email addresses.

Immediately upon realising this, contact was made with the recipient asking that he delete the incorrectly addressed email. He has confirmed that he did so.

As this represents a 'data breach' by the ROC, I have advised the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner (OAIC) of the incident as part of the data breach notification scheme, but have not provided them with any of your details or the contents of your contact with [REDACTED].
