

Actions arising from RF Review meeting 8 August 2012

Selection of members of expert panel

ARPANSA will document the process of selecting the experts

Conflict of interest

ARPANSA will prepare a pro-forma on conflict of interest to be signed by the external experts.

Provision of CVs

The experts are to provide brief CVs (about half a page) explaining their qualifications in relation to the RF review.

Terms of reference

Add to the terms of reference that apart from the report to the Radiation Health Committee the group will produce an independent assessment of the literature to be published.

Timing

Everyone agreed to the following timelines for the RF Review project.

- Review to be conducted during August and September 2012
- Meeting on 27 September to discuss drafting of the report
- Report finalized by late October 2012
- The assessment of the literature to be published could be finalised past October

It was noted that the external experts will notify ARPANSA if there is a problem with the timing.

Review

- It was agreed that the experts will look at the reviews and investigate special focus areas.
- Experts are to send a list of 'hot-topics' by the end of August.
- ARPANSA will also make a list of special areas of investigation for the experts.
- It was agreed that Andrew Wood will also look at dosimetric issues such as
 - derivation of reference levels from the basic restrictions (e.g. at 400 MHz)
 - development of RF absorption models
- Experts are to provide feedback on the format of the report to the RHC
