I refer to your email, dated 24 February 2014 in which you sought access, under the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 1982 to:

"Request the total quantity of:

1. Serving members of the Australian Defence Force whom are contributing members of the Military Superannuation and Benefits Scheme that have reached their maximum benefit limit (pension MBL) and,
2. Discharged members of the Australian Defence Force whom are preserved members of the Military Superannuation and Benefits Scheme that have reached their maximum benefit limit and have discharged from the ADF."

Your request has been processed pursuant to the *Freedom of Information Act 1982*.

ComSuper identified 456 Australian Defence Force members who are contributing members of the Military Superannuation and Benefits Scheme that have reached their maximum benefit limit. There are 119 Australian Defence Force members whom are preserved members of the Military Superannuation and Benefits Scheme that have reached their maximum benefit limit and have discharged from the ADF.

The FOI Act provides for rights of review of decisions. A copy of the fact sheet "Freedom of information -Your Review Rights" setting out your rights of review is attached.
