What have Papua New Guinea and Australia agreed to?

The new rules

When will this arrangement begin? Immediately.

Australia has already commenced working with PNG to expand the Manus Island Regional Processing Centre, as well as explore the construction of other regional processing Centres in Papua New Guinea.

Papua New Guinea has also agreed to take immediate steps to withdraw its reservations to the Refugees Convention, with respect to people transferred by Australia to PNG under this new arrangement.

Will children be transferred? Everyone who arrives after 19th July 2013 will be transferred once health checks are complete and appropriate accommodation is available. Children or family groups are not exempt from transfer. Exempting them would simply encourage people smugglers to put children on boats to Australia.

What about unaccompanied minors? While there are no blanket or broad exemptions to transfer to a regional processing country, Australia recognises that unaccompanied minors have particular guardianship and welfare requirements that need to be met.

Australian authorities will be working closely with their PNG counterparts to develop a framework of arrangements to cater for the needs of unaccompanied minors once they are transferred to PNG.

What if relatives are already in Australia? Is it any different if the relatives already have a permanent visa? It will not make a difference if people (including children, families or unaccompanied minors) have family in Australia. Everyone who arrives after 19 July 2013 will be transferred once health checks are complete and appropriate accommodation is available.

Unaccompanied minors are no exception to this established process.

Will children be settled in PNG? The Australian Government, in partnership with the PNG Government, will support settlement services for those with refugee status. This includes children and families.

Under the new agreement signed with Papua New Guinea (PNG) on 19 July 2013 – the Regional Settlement Arrangement – unauthorised maritime arrivals will be sent to Papua New Guinea for assessment and if found to be a refugee will be settled there.

People found not to be refugees may be returned to their home country or a country where they had a right of residence, or held in a transit facility.

What happens to pregnant women? Everyone who arrives after the announcement will be transferred once health checks are complete and appropriate accommodation is available.

There are no blanket exemptions for children or family groups – including pregnant women.

What will happen if asylum seekers make it to the mainland? Will they still be liable to be transferred to PNG under these arrangements? Recent amendments to the Migration Act now mean that mainland boat arrivals are treated the same as those who arrive at excised offshore places. No matter where an asylum seeker arrives in Australia by boat, they are subject to transfer to Papua New Guinea.

Is the government still committed to the increased humanitarian program intake? Yes. Australia's humanitarian program has increased to 20 000 places a year. This is the largest increase to Australia's humanitarian intake in 30 years.

Will people transferred to the new centres be subject to the same processing arrangements as those on Manus Island? Yes. Refugee status determinations will be made by PNG under PNG law.

What will happen to those people found not to be refugees? Those who are found not to be refugees will be expected to return to their home country or to a country where they have right of residence.

How many people can be transferred to PNG under the new arrangements? There is no maximum number. There is no limit on the number that may be transferred or settled in PNG under this arrangement.

You might have heard that it is possible to get to Australia by boat without a visa. The truth is that no one who travels to Australia illegally by boat is allowed to enter Australia.

Here are three common lies and truths about illegal migration to Australia.

LIE: Australian border protection policies will change after the next Australian election.

TRUTH: The Australian Government is committed to strong national borders, and discouraging people from risking their lives on unsafe people-smuggling boats. This will not change.

LIE: If I am a genuine refugee and travel to Australia by boat, I will be allowed to stay there.

TRUTH: If you travel to Australia on a boat without a visa, you will not be granted entry into Australia, even if you are a genuine refugee. There are no exceptions to Australia's strict border protection policies.

LIE: Regional processing centres are closing, and people in regional processing countries will be allowed to go to Australia.

TRUTH: Regional processing arrangements continue in the country of Nauru. Any person who is transferred to Nauru will not be resettled in Australia.

The Australian public's support for a well-managed migration programme and secure borders has been a key contributor to Australia's success as a multicultural nation.

Australia has strict border protection policies to combat people smuggling, prevent unlawful migration to Australia, and deter people from attempting unsafe journeys on people smuggling boats.

It is Australia's policy to turn back people smuggling boats where safe to do so. No-one who travels to Australia illegally by boat is allowed to enter Australia.

Since September 2013, Australia has intercepted 32 people smuggling boats and returned 800 people to their point of departure or their home country.

Unfortunately, people are still wasting their money and risking their lives trying to come to Australia the wrong way.

Protecting Australia's borders and combating people smuggling is not just a job for the Australian Government; everyone has a role to play.

You can help by telling people in your community, or friends and family living overseas, about Australia's strong border protection policies.

- ▶ Encourage people to come to Australia the right way; with an Australian visa.
- ▶ Explain that attempting to reach Australia illegally by boat is very dangerous and a waste of time and money.
