I'm following up again on the Communications data on NationalMap.

As a kindly reminder, last year we discussed the negative feedback we're getting for this data and some possible next steps.

I understand the data (Broadband availability) is not to be updated nor changed completely. Its currency and lack of clear legends attract a high number of negative feedback reflecting poorly on the NationalMap platform as a product.

Some of the next steps might include:

- To remove the Broadband availability completely
- Place the Communications group at the bottom of the catalogue
- Improve the legends of the data even if it's not updated and enlarge the data description text which mentions data hasn't been updated since 2015
- Produce a different dataset about internet availability

I understand started these discussions internally before he left. Let us know what you think.
