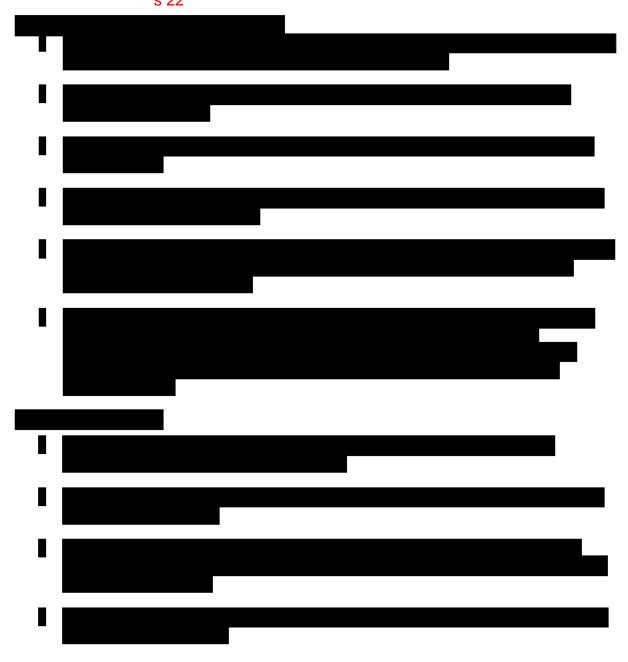
Fair Work Commission - Senate Estimates Brief February 2013

Subject: Name Change & FW Act Amendments Brief No: 2.1

SUMMARY:

The name change to the Fair Work Commission requires new artwork for building signage, letterhead etc.



Resources required:

 The cost of internal resources required to undertake the name change there was approximately \$97,508.26. A project committee of 13 staff which led this process.

- It should also be noted that our Web Services Team was required to work on both New Years Eve (a public holiday for all staff) and New Years Day (a national public holiday) to ensure that the name change was reflected on our website as of 1 January 2013.
- In terms of costs of using external agencies we have only incurred one cost currently which was for artwork and rebranding which was for \$2,100+ GST.
- Further costs will arise with the replacement of the current signage and stationery but
 we do not currently have these. These are being quoted with a view to undertaking
 this work by the end of February into early March.
