Project Update

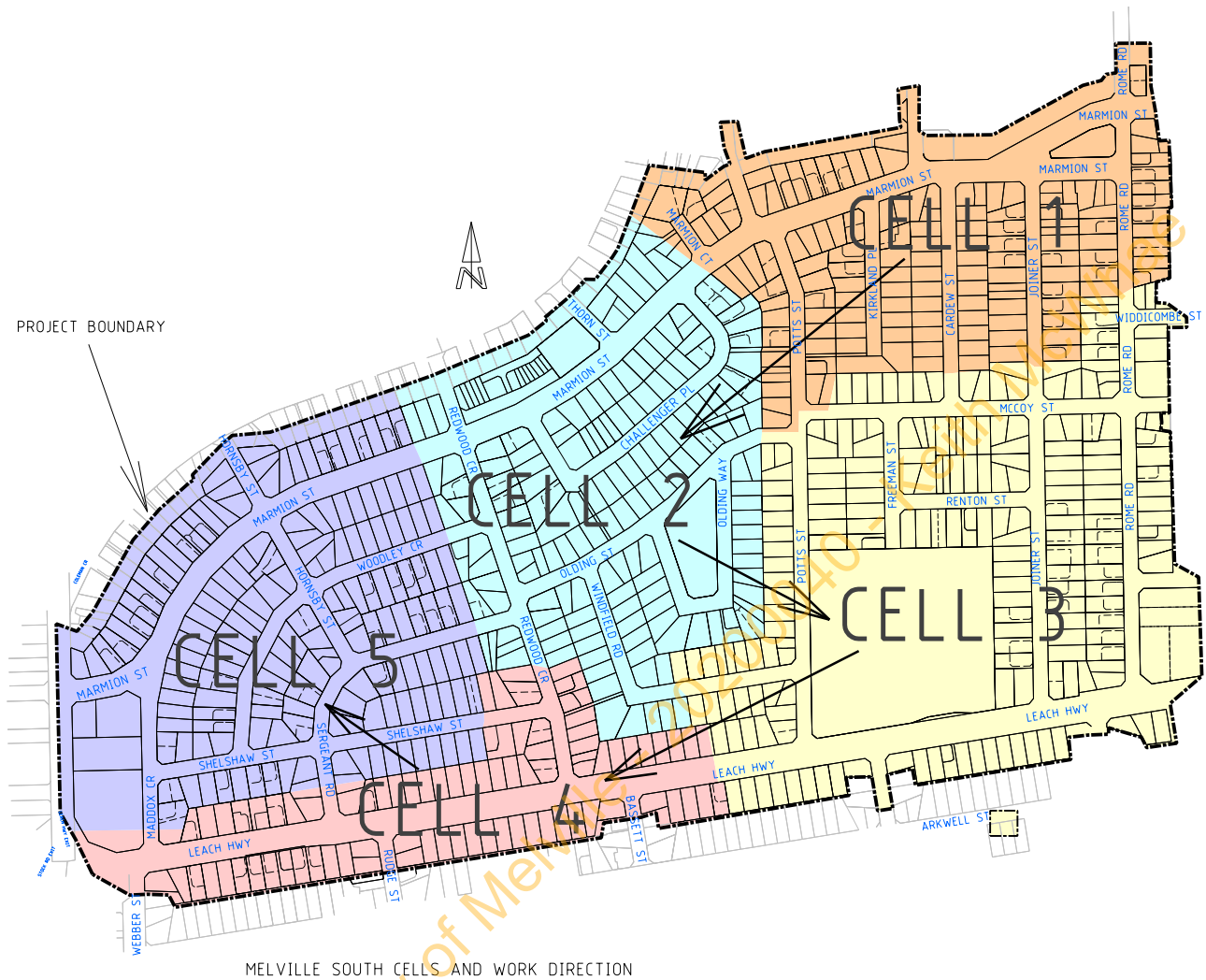
The design has been complete for some time and the necessary approvals from Western Power and the State Government are now being obtained. The project is expected to commence in late June 2015.

Please see the map on the back of this newsletter that shows the Cells in the project area and the direction the work will take through the project.

The civil contractors, **Diamond Communications**, are expected to commence the installation of underground cabling in the streets in Cell 1 near the intersection of Marmion Street and Rome Road in late June. The electrical contractors, **Sturton Holdings (Westralian Utility Services)**, who will be installing the new underground connections from the green dome locations to each meter box, will also commence work in the same area around that time.

A Startup Newsletter will be mailed to all property owners in early June with more details on the works and how they will be conducted including information on repairs and reinstatements and who to contact about these. The project will take around 18 months to complete.
