Freedom of Information (FOI reference 82269)

I refer to your request for documents under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (the FOI Act), received by the department on 25 August 2020, in which you sought access to:

Documents regarding the number of charges for unlawful use of force in Victorian Youth Detention From 1990-Present.

Application fee

Section 17(2A) of the FOI Act requires that an application fee of \$29.60 accompanies a request for access to documents. The fee can be paid by cheque or Money Order.
