Re Your FOI Request No. LS5106 - Documents and correspondence in relation to Michael Cordover and Matthew Landauer

I refer to your email of 21 July 2014 3:12 AM in which you request ('FOI Request') documents and correspondence in relation to Michael Cordover and Matthew Landauer under the <u>Freedom of Information Act 1982</u>.

#### Acknowledgment of FOI Request

The Australian Electoral Commission ('AEC') received your request on 21 July 2014 and the 30 day statutory period for processing your request commences from the day after that date. You should therefore expect a decision from us by 21 August 2014.

### Specification of the FOI Request

3 I have taken your request to be for:

all correspondence and documents, whether written or in email form, from the Special Minister of State's office and/or the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) relevant to:

- (i) the decision of the AEC to have Mr Michael Cordover declared a vexatious applicant, and
- (ii) the assertion that Mr Matthew Landauer colluded with Mr Cordover to harass the AEC.
- I have noted your request that that no names of personnel are censored where not otherwise required by relevant legislation.

# Extensions to the processing period

The period of 30 days may be extended if we need to consult third parties, impose a charge or for other reasons. We will advise you if this happens.

### Imposition of charges

You will be notified of any charges in relation to your request as soon as possible, before we process any requested documents or impose a final charge.
