FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST – NOTIFICATION OF RECEIPT

I am writing to notify you in accordance with paragraph 15(5)(a) of the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (FOI Act) of receipt on 27 October 2014 by the Department of Health (Department) of your request for access under the FOI Act to:

'Documents, briefings, notes and correspondence relating to the visit to Apotex with Canadian authorities in August 2014, the findings and subsequent decisions, including requirements and compliance measures for Apotex'

Your request will be processed in accordance with the provisions of the FOI Act, under which, the Department is required by paragraph 15(5)(b) to take all reasonable steps to notify you of a decision not later than 30 calendar days after the above receipt date.

In the case of your request, the due date for a decision is 26 November 2014 unless the 30 day period is extended for the reasons summarised below.

The 30-day period may be extended where either:

- we notify you that you are liable to pay a charge; or
- we are required to consult a third party,

in either of which you will be advised and given more details.

The time period may also be extended with your written agreement.
