### **Key Points:**

- Following your recent discussions with Apple and Google, you requested an update letter be prepared for the countries who participated in discussions on the Exposure Notification Framework (ENF). On 18 June 2020 and in the following weeks, you held discussions with Section 33
- 2. The letter (Attachment A) advises that you recently met with Section 47G

Section 47G

Australia continues to place its Health Officials at the centre of our successful public health response, which includes ensuring they have the data they need to be able to undertake mapping, identify the infection source, and contain the spread. This information is not provided under the ENF, which is intended as more of a notification service than a contact tracing tool.

3. The letter explains that Australia has identified Herald as a way to improve COVIDSafe's performance. Herald improves Bluetooth performance and retains flexibility in our response to COVID-19, unlike the ENF. Australia has contributed to Herald development and will continue to share our experiences with other countries who may be interested in Herald.

## BACKGROUND

- On 18 June 2020, you chaired an International Ministerial Meeting to discuss the ENF with
  other first-mover countries who had developed sovereign digital contact tracing solutions as part
  of their COVID-19 response.
- At the time, the ENF appeared to be the only technical way to improve COVIDSafe's Bluetooth performance, especially in background on iOS devices.

- In early October 2020, the DTA discovered the Herald Protocol, an alternative technical
  approach to improve Bluetooth performance without relying on the ENF. On 21 October 2020,
  you agreed to proceed with the implementation of Herald in COVIDSafe. Herald allows us to
  improve the Bluetooth performance of the app, while maintaining our sovereign public health
  response.
