# Freedom of Information (FOI) request - Access Decision

On 25 October 2021, the Department of Home Affairs (the Department) received a request for access to documents under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (the FOI Act).

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with a decision on your request for access under the FOI Act.

# 1 Scope of request

You have requested access to the following document:

I would like to enquire the figures of the following visa holders as per questions below:-

Q1: How many temporary visa holders, including (subclass 500, 485, 482, 457 & 476) that have an in-effect visa are outside Australia by Primary and Secondary applicants.

Q2: How many provisional visa holders, including subclass 489 & 491, have an in-effect visa are Outside Australia by Primary and Secondary applicants.

### 2 Authority to make decision

I am an officer authorised under section 23 of the FOI Act to make decisions in respect of requests to access documents or to amend or annotate records.
