RE: YOUR FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your application to the ABS for an Internal Review under the *Freedom of Information Act* 1982 (FOI Act) regarding the decisions made by Lewis Conn (Assistant Statistician), an authorised decision marker under section 23 of the FOI Act, to charge you for access to documents sought under the FOI Act.

Internal Review of the Decision:

I am an authorised decision maker under section 23 of the FOI Act and, in compliance with section 54C of the FOI Act, am an appropriate person to review the decision made by Lewis Conn.

Findings of the Internal Review:

I have assessed the information provided to the ABS to support your request to have fees waived on the grounds that it would cause you financial hardship. In this case, I have determined that the charges to be imposed on you will cause you financial hardship.

As a result, under section 54C of the FOI Act, I have decided to reverse the decision made by Lewis Conn and, under section 29(4) of the FOI Act, I have decided to waive all fees associated with processing this request.

The ABS has 16 calendar days from the date of this letter to provide you with access to the information you seek.

Information Commissioner Review of the Decision:

ATTACHMENT A

Review by the Information Commissioner

Section 54L of the FOI Act provides that a person may apply for a review to the Information Commissioner concerning the decision made by an agency on internal review of an original decision.

An application for a Review by the Information Commissioner must be occur within 60 days from the time that the agency has provided you with its decision. The application must be made in writing (including email) and should be directed to the following address:

An application for review through the Information Commissioner must include contact details for the applicant and a copy of the notice of decision as given by the agency under section 26.
