FOI REQUEST - REFERENCE NUMBER 2015-004

I refer to your request for access to documents under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (the FOI Act) in your email of 26 January 2015. Specifically, you have sought access to the following documents:

"A copy of all documents that contain a reference to "Taylor Swift" or "Shake It Off" that was produced [between 10 and 30 January] by staff of triple j.

In particular, I request all correspondence and documents relating to the decision to disqualify the Taylor Swift song 'Shake It Off' from the 2014 triple j Hottest 100.

I have recently finalised a decision in relation to an application under the FOI Act for virtually the same documents.
