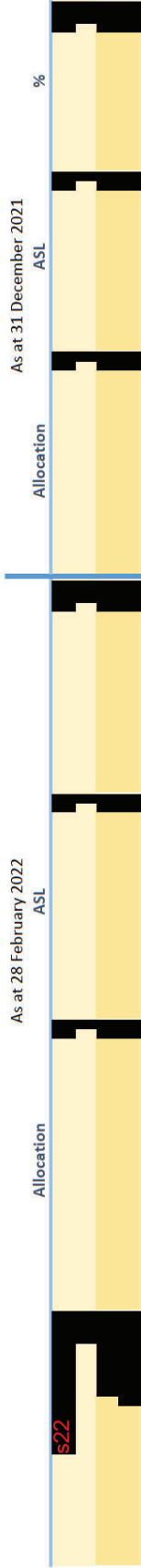
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Staffing allocation by function (APS staff)




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Senator WATERS: Ms Falk, in your report you said ongoing resourcing issues mean that a gap between incoming FOI work and finalisation work remains. Will the budget allocation for an FOI commissioner completely address this resources gap, or do you expect that there may still be a requirement for more resourcing to close that gap?

Ms Falk: Thank you. The appointment of an FOI commissioner together with an SES band 1 assistant commissioner for the area of FOI, plus some support staff, will be a welcome addition that will help to address the ongoing workload. s22

Senator KIM CARR: It was previously indicated that you needed an additional nine FOI officers, in terms of the increase in existing numbers. Is that still the case?

Ms Falk: Now that we have the budget announcement of \$980,000 for the next financial year for the FOI commissioner and for three additional staff, we are preparing to welcome the new commissioner and to look at what that will look like in terms of our future projections for the work of the office. s22
