It has migrated the management and booking functionality to the Customer First system and will enable progression to a single appointment system for the department.

The system allows appointments to be booked and managed by staff, and certain appointment types to be rescheduled by customers.

The DHS Appointments System will notify and remind customers of their appointments using Email/SMS, or letters where the customer does not use Electronic Messaging.
