## Freedom of Information (FOI) request – Access Decision

On 22 August 2022, the Department of Home Affairs (the Department) received a request for access to documents under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (the FOI Act).

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with a decision on your request for access under the FOI Act.

## 1 Scope of request

You have requested access to the following documents:

- 1. How many decisions did the Hon Karen Andrews MP personally make under the following sections of the Migration Act 1958 (Cth): 501J, 501, 500A, 501, 501B, 501BA, 501CA, 501CA, 501D? To clarify, what is sought is the aggregate number of decisions, not the number of decisions under each of those sections.
- 2. How many decisions were favourable to the non-citizens the subject of such decisions, out of the decisions referred to in question 1 above? Please treat a favourable decision as a decision to not cancel a visa, not refuse to grant a visa or to revoke the cancellation of a visa. Please treat a decision to set aside a decision of the Administrative Appeals Tribunal (AAT): and refuse to grant a visa as a decision to refuse to grant a visa; and cancel a visa as a decision to cancel a visa.

## 2 Authority to make decision

I am an officer authorised under section 23 of the FOI Act to make decisions in respect of requests to access documents or to amend or annotate records.

#### 3 Relevant material

In reaching my decision I referred to the following:

- the terms of your request
- the document relevant to the request
- the FOI Act
- Guidelines published by the Office of the Information Commissioner under section 93A of the FOI Act (the FOI Guidelines)
- advice from departmental officers with responsibility for matters relating to the document to which you sought access

## 4 Document in scope of request

In accordance with section 17 of the FOI Act, the Department has used its computer system to produce one document that contains information that falls within the scope of your request. The data produced in the document existed in the possession of the Department on 22 August 2022 when your FOI request was received.
