In the period that the Hon Karen Andrews MP was Minister for Home Affairs, she made fewer than five decisions under the following sections of the *Migration Act 1958*: 501J, 501, 500A, 501, 501B, 501BA, 501C, 501A, 501CA, 501D.

Each decision was either to cancel or refuse a visa.

Caveats:

- Figures were extracted from Departmental systems on 8 August 2022. As data has been drawn from a live systems environment, the figures provided may differ slightly in previous or future reporting.
- Regarding Immigration data, the Department's current policy is to mask numbers which are less than five as <5, noting we are reviewing the confidentiality method for the future.
